Decking the Halls



HTS Receives an Early Christmas Present

Holy Trinity Seminary is excited to announce the receipt of a \$200,000 grant from the **CONSTANTIN FOUNDATION** earmarked for the Cardinal Farrell Student Center and extends its sincere gratitude to the foundation and its board members for their very generous support of this project.

The Cardinal Farrell Student Center will expand the current footprint of the Seminary with a 23,000 square foot addition that will give our seminarians the gym and fitness rooms they need to say healthy; the lounge, kitchen and recreation room they need to build healthy bonds of fraternity; and the classrooms they need for group formation and a quiet place to study. The groundbreaking for this project, which was to have taken place this fall, has been delayed until January 2018 due, in part, to the shortage of construction materials caused by the recent hurricanes.

Grant proposals for this project have been submitted to other foundations as well, and we hope to share even more good news with you in the near future. Even so, additional funds are needed to complete and furnish this much-needed student center.
