
### **40 Days of Reflection**

Please accompany the seminarians on their Lenten journey by following their **Facebook page** and reading their #40 Reflections (see today's reflection below). A new Lenten reflection will be posted each Monday through Saturday during Lent.

As part of their Lenten journey, the seminarians will gather as a community on two separate Fridays to reflect more deeply on Christ's passion during *Stations of the Cross* devotions.

The seminarians will experience one of the most sacred moments of their year during 40 Hours Devotion, which will occur the last weekend in February. The practice of this devotion began in Italy in the 1500s to commemorate the "40" hours that Jesus lay in the tomb before his resurrection. This beautiful devotion begins and ends with processions accompanied by incense and bells, and is followed by the seminarians keeping watch with our Blessed Lord as the Blessed Sacrament is solemnly exposed and adored for three days, around the clock.

While these devotions are not open to the public, please know that the seminarians will be praying for the intentions of the entire Holy Trinity Seminary community during this time.



The *Living Stations of the Cross*, a hallmark of Holy Trinity Seminary's observance of Palm Sunday, will be presented on March 25. Together with students from the University of Dallas, the seminarians will piously portray dramatic "freeze frames" of each Station and invite attendees to join them in reflecting on the mystery of Christ's passion and death.

We hope you will you will include us in your Lenten journey and join us for this presentation. Admission is free, and a reception with the seminarians follows.






# **THANK YOU**
