Over the last two weeks, 73 seminarians have settled in at Holy Trinity Seminary to discern their vocations to the priesthood. They represent 13 different dioceses across the United States: the Diocese of Dallas - 24; the Diocese of Austin - 6; the Diocese of Charleston - 5; the Diocese of Corpus Christi - 1; the Diocese of El Paso - 3; the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston - 5; the Diocese of Knoxville - 4; the Diocese of Memphis - 4; the Diocese of Nashville - 8; The Diocese of Tulsa - 2; the Diocese of Tyler - 5; the Diocese of Victoria - 2; and the Diocese of Wichita - 4.

An Orientation Team of 9 seminarians greeted the 32 new seminarians and their families as they arrived on August 12. After helping with move-in and attending Mass, the new parents left their sons in the care of the Orientation Team to begin a 9-day introduction to their new lives. The next week was spent getting acquainted with one another and the formation program, praying together as a community and learning their way around the seminary.
