ARRIVAL OF PROPAEDEUTIC SEMINARIANS

A new year has begun at Holy Trinity Seminary, and with it has come a significant change. This year marks the beginning of a new stage in seminary formation, the propaedeutic stage, in which men new to priestly formation spend a year focusing on their spiritual and human formation in a particular way before beginning their philosophy studies in the discipleship stage.

An Orientation Team made up of 10 returning seminarians arrived on campus early to prepare for the 20 new men arriving for their propaedeutic year. The team introduced the new men to seminary life and helped them familiarize themselves with the seminary campus, especially the new propaedeutic floor.

Designed specifically for the propaedeutic program, the floor includes two classrooms, a kitchen, an assembly room, a refectory, a student lounge, a sacristy, and the new St. Joseph Oratory. In a beautiful ceremony held on Thursday, August 17, Bishop **Greg Kelly**, a beloved resident of the seminary, blessed the new oratory.
